Professor Christine Bigby

Professor Christine Bigby is the Director of the multi-disciplinary Living with Disability Research Centre at La Trobe University. The focus of her work is policy issues, program effectiveness and front line practice that supports quality of life outcomes for people with intellectual disability. She has also extensively researched issues of aging for people with intellectual disability and wrote the first Australian texts on this issue. She is Fellow of the International Association for the Scientific Study of Intellectual Disability, past chair of the IASSID Special Interest Group on Ageing and Intellectual Disability, a National Board member of ASID – Research to Practice, founding Editor of Research and Practice in Intellectual Disability (RAPIDD).
